Next-gen firewalls

Trends in IT security develop at an incredibly rapid pace. That's why NetStream advises customers to check the security of their networks on a regular basis. "A recent review showed that our Sophos firewalls were reaching the end of their life cycle," Versluis says. "It was an opportune moment to transition to the latest generation of firewalls." In consultation with NetStream, Versluis opted for the XG Firewalls from Sophos. "With the previous firewalls, we were almost at maximum capacity. The next generation of firewall clusters offers advanced functionality combined with scalability that is more than sufficient for our needs."

No security risks

Meticulous planning and preparation took place before replacing the firewalls with the new clusters. Versluis explains, "We worked with NetStream to design an implementation plan that guarantees continuity of our services. And of course we don't want any security risks during the roll-out." Firewall replacement started at the biggest branch locations in Utrecht and Eemshaven. Roll-out at all the other branch locations will take place in the upcoming period. The project plan stated that NetStream would arrange all the technical aspects of the firewalls and implementation, while Versluis would handle functional planning and coordinate communication with the business. Thanks to the thorough preparations, the new firewalls were implemented in a single weekend, without any problems at all.

Comprehensive solutions

The Theo Pouw Group also relies on NetStream for management and monitoring. NetStream monitors the environment proactively and 24/7, benefiting from the comprehensive solutions that Sophos offers. Following the implementation, Versluis is already looking to the future. "NetStream keeps our security environment up to date. In addition, they give tangible advice on how we can use the next-gen functionality of the firewalls. Among other things, we are considering microsegmentation to keep optimizing security. Setting up segments makes it possible to achieve more densely deployed security without increasing management. But we also want to address aspects like two-factor authentication, endpoint security and the security of our SD-WAN environment in the near future."

The new firewall clusters give Theo Pouw Group a solid and scalable foundation to support further growth. Versluis adds a final note: "Security is a dynamic field.
